GENERAL PRINCIPLES

Párisi Udvar Hotel Passage opening hours:

Monday-Sunday: 10:00 - 22:00

The Párisi Udvar Hotel's passage is a private area open to the public, where the operator is entitled to make its services subject to conditions that it sets itself, and which are summarised in the hotel's rules.

The rules and principles, the observance of which contributes to the high level of operation, the establishment, maintenance and enhancement of the reputation of the Párisi Udvar Hotel's Passage (hereinafter referred to as the Passage), and to the uninterrupted enjoyment, relaxation, recreation and entertainment of its visitors.

Compliance with the rules set out in this document is binding to all persons and guests (hereinafter referred to as „guests“) present at the passage.

Guests must respect the dignity and personal rights of hotel's restaurant staff and security guards.

A maximum of 5 walk-in visitors are allowed at a time at the passage. Groups of more than 5 visitors can only be accepted by prior arrangement. For further information please contact us on +36 1 576 1600 or at: info@parisiudvarhotel.com.

The furnishings in the passage are for the use of our guests and are not available to visitors using the passage for transit purposes only.

It is the responsibility of the guest accompanying the child to ensure the safety and physical well-being of the children, to inform the children about the rules of the passage and the restaurant and to comply with the rules.

Respect for other guests, civilised behaviour and appropriate attire is essential.

Only dogs on a leash and with jaw muzzles attached may be brought into the passage and restaurant area. No other pets are allowed.

PROHIBITIONS

- No helmets, full-face coveralls, swimwear, inappropriate attire, or bare feet allowed.
- No bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller skates or other means of transport are allowed on the site.
- No photography or video recording without permission. To obtain a permit, please contact us on +36 1 576 1600 or info@parisiudvarhotel.com
- No advertising or other commercial activities of any kind is allowed at the passage.
- It is forbidden to consume food or drinks purchased elsewhere at the passage or at the restaurant.
- Smoking and the use of electric cigarettes is prohibited at the passage.
- The use of open flames, the lighting of lighters or any other means of lighting a fire in the Passage area is prohibited.
- It is prohibited to possess, distribute, or consume drugs on the premises.
- It is forbidden to bring into the area of the passage any sharp / pointed edge objects, weapons, pyrotechnic device or other alarming device, or any object capable, or appearing capable of discharging a projectile or causing injury.

The operator reserves the right to decide which items fall into this category, depending on the situation.

Anyone who engages in provocatively anti-communal, violent behaviour likely to cause offence or alarm in others, or who resists by force or threat against a lawful measure taken by the organiser or director of a public event or gathering to maintain order, may be escorted out by the security service and may be subject to a police report.

No activities in the area of the passage may be carried out which cause excessive noise, odours or other environmental nuisance, or which are likely to disturb persons in the area of the passage or restaurant.

No activity beyond the intended use of the building or any other commercial activity shall be carried out in the entire area of the Passage unless authorised by the Hotel Manager.

Persons who violate the above general principles and standards of behaviour may be refused service by the restaurant staff or escorted out of the passage by security personnel upon request.

This policy is valid until revoked.
